Requirements- Qualified applicants must hold a journeyman lineman certificate or have completed an accredited apprenticeship training program. Must have a current Montana driver's license with class A CDL Endorsement or be able to obtain one within six months of hire date. Other requirements include, but are not limited to: experience working on energized overhead and underground lines, experience with operation and maintenance of substations, transmission, and distribution systems. Preferred applicants will have a minimum of 5 years of experience and knowledge of RUS standards and specifications.

Glacier Electric Cooperative serves 5,000 members through 212 miles of transmission line and 1 625 miles of distribution line. GEC's service territory includes part of Glacier National Park and the area offers hunting, fishing, hiking, and golf.
