Glacier Electric Cooperative is seeking two temporary apprentice lineworkers who are interested in a career in linework. We will offer two positions, one in our Browning area and one in our Cut Bank area. The position will run from June 1st through August 31st, 2021 and is only open to current 2021 high school graduates. The hope is to draw attention to a great trade and encourage students to enroll in a pre-apprentice lineman program. A scholarship opportunity will be available at the end of August.

Required Skills/Qualifications: The successful candidate will possess a great attitude, personality and work ethic and be committed to safety and service to our members. Apprentice will work under the direct supervision of a Journeyman Lineman or Foreman. Duties include constructing, repairing, and maintaining lines, structures, and equipment involved in the distribution and transmission of electricity. Must meet all physical, educational, and regulatory qualifications of an apprenticeship program. Must have a valid Montana Driver's License.

Education/Experience: Minimum of a high school diploma or GED required.

Lifting Capacity: Must be able to lift 75 pounds.

Compensation: \$20.61/hr.

The successful candidate must pass an initial substance screening and, as an employee, will be subject to random drug/controlled substance screenings.
